A features "standard" has been set in most of our jacket styles. However, customizations can be made that don't affect the design panels. Additional charges may apply depending upon the detail or hardware expense of the change. Also, some jacket styles may not accommodate certain options – i.e. jackets with raglan sleeves (baseball shirt cut) cannot be made with a zip-off sleeve option. Completely custom jackets can be designed for orders of 100+ pieces. Following are common adjustments you can make to any style with orders of at least 50 or more.
